In 2023, the program was successfully piloted in Brazil, making translated, culturally relevant, and locally adapted ISPE resources available in the country for the first time. ISPE worked closely with both the ISPE Ibiza Affiliate and ANVISA to drive adoption for this program. The finalized translated courses have been entered into ISPE's Learning Management System for ondemand, online delivery, which expands our ability to provide these resources in Portuguese.
